Marine injured during training at live fire range

QUANTICO, Va. – A Marine was injured with a gunshot wound to the back during live fire training here at approximately 9 a.m. today.

The name of the injured individual is being withheld until notification of next of kin.

Medical personnel on site tended to the Marine and listed the individual's condition as stable. The Marine was then transported via helicopter to Inova Fairfax Hospital where the individual's condition has been listed as stable.

The Marine is a range coach with Weapons Training Battalion aboard Marine Corps Base Quantico.

The range where the incident occurred has been shut down until further notice, and the cause of the incident is under investigation.
