Marine injured during training Friday released from Inova Fairfax Hospital

QUANTICO, Va. – Sgt. Alexander Pak, the Marine injured Friday during live-fire training here, was released from Inova Fairfax Hospital the same day after medical personnel determined his injury was not serious.

Pak, a range coach with Weapons Training Battalion here, received a gunshot wound to the back and was treated by medical personnel on site before being transported by helicopter to the hospital.

The range where the incident occurred was immediately shut down and is still not fully operational as the incident remains under investigation.
