Subj: LITTERING

1. Purpose. To prohibit littering by any person, military or civilian, aboard MCB, Quantico.

2. Cancellation. MCBO 11014.1.

3. Summary of Revision. This revision contains minor administrative changes and updates the phone numbers listed in paragraph 5c.

4. Information

a. Applicability. This Order applies to all operators and passengers of privately, commercially, and government owned vehicles, motorcyclists, bicyclists, horseback riders, and pedestrians that are located anywhere aboard this Base. Any violation of this Order will subject the violator to judicial or administrative action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice or federal laws.

b. Assimilation of Commonwealth of Virginia Law. Except where clearly inapplicable or contrary to the specific provisions of this Order or federal law, the provisions of reference (a), as presently in force, and as hereinafter supplemented or modified, are assimilated under reference (b) as the littering regulations for this Base. Reference (a) prohibits disposing of trash, garbage, refuse, or other unsightly matter on a public highway, right of way, or private property without the written consent of the owner or their agent.

c. Disposition of Offenses

(1) Nonmilitary adults. Nonmilitary adults who violate this Order may be prosecuted pursuant to reference (c).

(2) Military personnel. Civilian employees, service members, and military dependents who violate this Order may be prosecuted in MCB Traffic Court pursuant to reference (d). Additionally, service members who violate this Order may also be punished for violating reference (e).


(3) Juveniles. Juveniles who violate this Order may be prosecuted pursuant to reference (f).

5. Action

a. No person shall willfully place, deposit, or leave any litter, refuse, debris, or waste material aboard this Base, other than in a receptacle or place specifically designated and authorized for that purpose.

b. Activity heads and other responsible persons will give this Order the widest possible dissemination to ensure compliance.

c. All personnel will report violations of this Order to the Provost Marshal's Office, extension 4-2252/2253, by furnishing pertinent information, e.g., license plate number, location, etc.
